Chief Counsel Rod Diaz explained that the Liquor Code authorizes distributors and importing distributors to sell only sell malt and brewed beverages; anything else they want to sell must have specific approval from the Board. The other items that the Board has granted authority for distributors and importing distributors to sell are listed in Advisory Notice No. 9.

Before the Board is the proposed 11th revision, being revised at the request of the Malt Beverage Distributors Association. The Board had previously allowed other licensees to sell certain CBD products, but had expressly not given that authority to distributors and importing distributors. This request allows distributors and importing distributors to sell CBD gummies, non-alcoholic beverages that include CBD, and health and nutritional supplements such as vitamins, oils, lotions and creams, including those that include CBD. These types of items without CBD can already be sold by distributors and importing distributors; however, this revision includes those items having CBD as an approved ingredient.
