Armstrong-Indiana-Clarion Drug and Alcohol Commission	\$40,000	Project includes Too Good for Drugs and Alcohol and MADD's Power of Parents programs.
Bloomsburg Police Department	\$40,000	Project includes the purchase of body cameras and reimbursement for security overtime, training, and travel to the PLCB conference.
Bloomsburg University	\$40,000	Project includes administration of the National Collegiate Health Association survey, purchase of bicycle equipment, provision of enforcement details, and training peer educators.
Community Health Council of Lebanon County	\$40,000	Funding is for Project Northland, a research-informed prevention strategy to deter underage and dangerous drinking.
Duquesne University	\$40,000	Project includes Duquesne's DU Cares (which is designed to educate students on how to make the most informed decision on the use of alcohol), the purchase of Breathalyzers, and police enforcement patrols.
Elizabethtown Area Communities That Care	\$40,000	Funding is for the MADD Power of Parents program, evaluations, posters, yard signs, and attending the SADD conference.
Healthy Communities Partnership	\$40,000	Project includes Parents Who Host, Teens For a Better Tomorrow advisory board, Project Sticker Shock, Power of Parents, and Strengthening Families Program (10-14).
Holcomb Behavioral Health Systems	\$40,000	Funding is for a prevention specialist to provide MADD's Power of Parents training and to purchase the accompanying curriculum and materials for teens.
Indiana Borough Police Department	\$40,000	Funding is for enforcement detail officer overtime.
Lackawanna College	\$40,000	Funding is for the Alcohol Wise educational program and the Photo Voice Project, a social norms program.
Millersville Borough	\$40,000	Project includes officer overtime, camera purchase, Breathalyzer purchase, Facebook and news advertising, PLCB annual conference attendance, and educational components.
Plymouth Township Police Department	\$40,000	Funding for school programs (Alcohol Education/Survival 101), community events, and underage drinking law enforcement overtime initiatives.
Pocono Mountain Regional Police Department	\$40,000	Project includes specialized patrols, billboard, and print ad campaign.

Scott Township (Allegheny County)	\$40,000	Funding is to support enforcement patrols.
State College Borough Police Department	\$40,000	Project includes the distribution of Party Smart guides, purchase of a Breathalyzer, and officer detail overtime.
Stroud Area Regional Police Department	\$40,000	Project includes officer overtime for quality of life patrols and collaboration with East Stroudsburg University.
The Learning Lamp, Inc.	\$40,000	Project includes the Alcohol Literacy Challenge, Power of Parents, office supplies, staff expenses for coordination and facilitation of programs, and attendance at the PLCB conference.
The University of Scranton	\$40,000	Project includes AlcoholEDU, curriculum infusion, increased university police patrols targeting RUDD, and "Late Night at Scranton" programming.
To Our Children's Future With Health, Inc.	\$40,000	Project includes Philly on the Come Up project, which involves social norming; the Prom Promise Refusal Skills Project for high school youth; Project ALERT Curriculum; and the Philly Mural Arts Initiative.
Juniata College	\$39,998	Project includes administration of the AlcoholEDU survey, civility patrols, and collaboration with Huntingdon Borough Police project.
Hazleton City Police Department	\$39,997	Project includes law enforcement patrols to identify and prevent underage and dangerous consumption of alcohol that will be enhanced during significant school events and holidays.
Shalom, Inc.	\$39,974	Funding is for advertisement, surveys, office supplies, prevention specialists for social norms, and conferences.
Fayette County Drug & Alcohol Commission, Inc.	\$39,970	Project includes the Parents Who Host campaign and MADD Power of Parents trainings.
Albright College	\$39,955	This grant will fund screening, counseling, neighborhood town-gown meetings, peer educator and alcohol education meetings. Reading Police Patrols and Resident Assistance training are also planned.
Home Rule Borough of Edinboro	\$39,926	Project includes officer overtime, purchase of a camera and Breathalyzer, Facebook and news advertising, and attendance at the PLCB annual conference.
City of Shamokin Police Department	\$39,924	Project includes overtime for RUDD enforcement, source investigation initiatives, underage DUI patrols, and uniform bike patrols.

Neumann University	\$39,922	Project includes AlcoholEDU, PLCB conference attendance, Campus-Community Alcohol and Other Drug Coalition establishment, creation of a "Good Neighbor" brochure, purchase and use of the Intoxiclock Interactive Blood Alcohol Concentration Education Tool, and Core surveys.
Lafayette College	\$39,856	Project includes increased patrols on and off campus, creation of social norms poster, media and social media campaign, and peer educator sessions.
Saint Francis University	\$39,804	Funding is for the continuation of the INTERCEPT Program, hiring of an alcohol education specialist, and enforcement details. Additionally, funding is to provide a Parent Partnership Program to engage parents of college students in the prevention of alcohol misuse.
Lehigh Township Board of Supervisors	\$39,654	Funding is for advertising pamphlets, purchase of a Breathalyzer, officer overtime, and PLCB conference attendance.
Haverford Township Police Department	\$39,652	Funding is to support additional law enforcement details, the purchase of crimes code and vehicle law handbooks, educational programs, and development of a social media campaign.
Whitemarsh Township Police Department	\$39,620	Project includes enforcement patrols and educational components.
Springfield Township Police Department	\$39,565	Funding is for officer overtime for RUDD enforcement.
Slippery Rock University	\$39,447	Project includes alcohol enforcement patrols, MyStudentBody, Peer-to-Peer Education Programs, and social marketing/promotion.
Valley Forge Military Academy Foundation	\$39,252	Project includes Alcohol Wise educational program and enforcement patrols.
Center For Youth & Community Development	\$39,230	This grant includes providing MADD's Power of Parents training, Parents Who Host campaign, and Strengthening Families Program.
East Stroudsburg University of Pennsylvania	\$39,010	Funding is for social norms posters, advertisement, MADD Power of Parents, peer educators, and attendance at PLCB conference.
La Salle University	\$38,853	Funding is for an increase in 35th district patrols, expanded on-campus bike patrols, the use student block representatives and to purchase ID card readers.
North Cornwall Township	\$38,545	Funding is for officer overtime and the purchase of a speed timing device.
Family Services of Montgomery County	\$38,116	This grant will use the Strengthening Families Program for 10-14-year-olds. SFP is an evidence-based family skills training program found to significantly improve parenting skills and family relationships, reduce problem behaviors, delinquency and alcohol and drug abuse in children and to improve social competencies and school performance.

Carnegie Mellon University	\$37,867	Project will provide additional law enforcement details and will expand their underage drinking/dangerous drinking alcohol awareness education programs.
Marlborough Township Police Department	\$37,434	Funding is for officer training, equipment purchase, and enforcement details: roving, traffic, and foot patrols.
Lehigh University	\$37,200	Project includes BUZZKILL, a program on the dangers of alcohol misuse; partnership with local police to target underage drinking; and, educational component for the local licensed establishments.
Central Bucks Regional Police Department	\$36,254	Funding is for public service announcements, foot and bike patrols, roaming vehicle patrols, and attendance at the annual PLCB Conference.
Kutztown University	\$36,213	Funding is for the administration of the National College Health Assessment (NCHA) and the AlcoholEDU assessment. Additionally, Communities Mobilizing for Change on Alcohol (CMCA) Peer-to-Peer Education Programs.
YWCA York	\$36,120	Funding is for the support of Project Towards No Drug Abuse (TND), which is designed for at-risk high school students in York City.
Locust Township Police Department	\$35,876	Project includes enforcement patrols and collaboration with Wildlife Officers, Waterways Officers, and the Sheriff's Department.
Township of Spring Police Department	\$34,685	Funding for officer overtime for enforcement details and the purchase of a Breathalyzer.
Clarion University	\$34,344	Project includes law enforcement patrols and expansion of Good Neighbor walk-throughs used to talk to community leaders and college students.
King's College	\$34,288	Funding is for the development and implementation of an alcohol education and awareness program, to provide enhanced patrols, attendance the PLCB conference, and production of an alcohol education and awareness video.
Emmaus Police Department	\$31,882	Funding is for newspaper advertisements, the purchase of a Breathalyzer, officer overtime, and training.
Venango County Substance Abuse Program	\$29,584	Project includes underage drinking prevention and law enforcement programs, Too Good for Drugs, Law Enforcement training, and advertisement.
Upper Dublin Township Police Department	\$27,472	Funding is for a community education program, the purchase of a bike, and increased enforcement details.
Immaculata University	\$27,284	Project includes administration of the Core Alcohol and Drug Survey, administration of AlcoholEDU, the provision of the CHOICES program, and RA Training.

Wyomissing Borough Police Department	\$26,336	Project includes enforcement partnership with the local university and rental community.
Quaker Valley School District Police	\$26,000	Project includes enforcement patrols around the school district during special events and weekends: football games, prom, dance nights, etc.
Children's Aid Home Programs of Somerset County	\$24,220	Funding is for Project ADAPT (Alcohol Diversion and Program Training ) and will be expanded to work with the judicial system and juveniles.
Erie Downtown Partnership	\$24,000	Project will provide an increase in security personnel for enforcement of dangerous and underage drinking during planned city street fairs.
Twin Lakes Center, Inc.	\$22,833	Project includes Elementary Botvin Life skills program, MADD Power of Parents Program, HALO Program, and PLCB and Commonwealth Prevention Alliance conferences.
Scott Township Police (Columbia County)	\$21,728	Funding is to provide alcohol enforcement patrols.
West Chester Area School District	\$19,052	Funding is for the MADD Power of Parents and Parents Who Host programs.
The Pennsylvania State University - Berks Campus	\$18,556	Funding is for enforcement patrols, attendance at the PLCB conference, Core surveys, and the purchase of bicycle supplies and flashlights.
Greene County Human Services Drug & Alcohol program	\$17,648	Funding to provide Project Towards No Drug Abuse Curriculum, which includes an alcohol prevention component.
University of the Sciences in Philadelphia	\$14,787	Project includes CHOICES program, the NCAA-approved e-CHUG assessment and survey, and educational materials for the student body.
Drexel University Public Safety	\$10,235	Funding is for Don't Stall, Just Call presentations, targeted enforcement patrols, the purchase of a police bike, and attendance at the PLCB conference.
Derry Township Police Department	\$2,922	Funding is for the purchase of law enforcement equipment (Breathalyzer and bicycle light) for use in enhanced details for underage drinking.
