



## QUOTA VACANCIES

The 2010 decennial census created openings in the quota in certain counties for restaurant (R) and eating place retail dispenser (E) licenses. Quotas are set based on county population. Section 461 of the Liquor Code allows one "R" or "E" license for each 3,000 inhabitants in the county. Section 404 of the Liquor Code states in part that: upon any opening in any quota, an application for a new license shall only be filed with the board for a period of six months following said opening. The Bureau of Licensing is currently accepting and processing applications for the following counties.

### Juniata

Openings currently exist for Distributors (D) and Importing Distributors (ID). Section 437 (f) of the Liquor Code states in part that: one license for each 30,000 inhabitants of the county in which the license is to be issued: Provided, that a combined total of five such licenses may be granted in any county of the Commonwealth. The Bureau of Licensing is currently accepting and processing applications for the following counties:
