

Supplier – Create and Submit Items in Oracle Supplier Portal Quick Reference Guide

Introduction

The new Oracle Supplier Portal allows suppliers to the PLCB of spirits, wines, consumables and accessories to initiate item creation and make updates to items.

This Quick Reference Guide (QRG) shows suppliers how to use the new Supplier Portal to submit requests for stock items stored in a PLCB distribution center (DC) and for direct store delivery (DSD) items sent directly to Fine Wine & Good Spirits stores.

Before You Begin

There are two prerequisites to creating items in the Supplier Portal. First, you must register with the PLCB as a supplier. Second, your items must have gone through the negotiation process and been agreed to by PLCB Product Management. You do not have to wait for PLCB Board approval to enter and save your items but should wait until the negotiation is complete before submitting items to ensure negotiation information is in the system.

Important Terminology

The items you supply to the PLCB are organized into a hierarchy to support purchasing transactions, inventory management and shipping. Understanding the terminology below will help you when creating items in the Supplier Portal. Also, please review the [Attribute Definitions](#) at the end of this document for more information about the fields in the system.

Parent Item

The first level of the hierarchy represents a sellable and orderable item and is referred to as the Parent Item. These are typically quantified and considered in eaches or units. For example, a Parent Item can be a single item or a multi-pack sold as a single unit.

There are several barcode types and numbers that identify Parent Items in the Oracle Supplier Portal, and you will supply one of these when submitting item requests. Most often this will be a 12-digit Universal Product Code or UPC-A. As you will see in the steps, the field is called “UPC Type.” However, the following numeric barcode types are available in the Oracle Supplier Portal:

- EAN13, which is the European Article Number (EAN) and 13 digits, more common on European items.
- EAN8, which is the EAN, based on EAN13, 8 digits, more common on European items and designed to be shorter to fit on smaller items.
- ISBN10, which is the International Standard Book Number (ISBN) 10 and 10 digits, commonly used on books and not typically used at the PLCB.
- ISBN13, which is the ISBN 13, 13 digits and the newer version of ISBN10. This is not typically used at the PLCB.
- UPC-A, which is the Universal Product Code (UPC) often associated with consumer products in North America. This number is the preferred type for the Parent Item and is 12 digits.
- UPC-E, which is the UPC E and 8 digits with the first value as zero and the last value as the check digit, like the UPC-A. The 6 digits in between represent a “suppressed” version of the UPC-A, designed to be shorter to fit on smaller items, such as mini bottles. The Oracle Supplier Portal requires all 8 digits when UPC-E is the barcode type.

While the field containing the barcode number in the Oracle Supplier Portal is labeled “Supplier UPC,” you will enter the corresponding number to the barcode type as described above.

Supplier Shipping Container Code (SCC)/Global Trade Item Number (GTIN) Item

The second level of the hierarchy represents the physical product case, which contains the sellable Parent Item. This level is a way to track cases including multiples of the Parent Item under one item number. Once you submit a Parent Item, you can create a Supplier SCC/GTIN item request immediately thereafter. When you submit a Supplier SCC/GTIN, you will again provide the same value for “Supplier UPC” you provided for the Parent Item, as well as the Supplier SCC/GTIN number.

When PLCB processes the item, the system will link the two items using the Parent Item barcode type and number provided. DSD items do not have an associated Supplier SCC/GTIN.

Other System Numbers

After items are submitted in the Oracle Supplier Portal, the Parent and Supplier SCC/GTIN items are each assigned a 9-digit PLCB item number, which is how the PLCB commonly refers to the items in the system, although these numbers will not be visible in the Manage Products area of the Oracle Supplier Portal.

The 9-digit item number will also be exposed on FWGS.com and the Licensee Online Order Portal (LOOP). LOOP will also feature Supplier SCC/GTIN numbers for Licensee Delivery Program (LDP) customers.

Item Entry Process Overview

The Oracle Supplier Portal supports the creation of both Parent and Supplier SCC/GTIN items described above. System attributes – or fields – provide a way to record specific item information to pass along to the PLCB. This document is organized so that the user can follow steps that apply to all Parent Items, then to the section with the steps to enter attributes for a specific type of Parent Item (spirits, wines, consumables or accessories).

In most cases, users will first follow the steps to enter a Parent Item (for example, stock wines or spirits), add document attachments and bottle images, then create the Supplier SCC/GTIN for the associated Parent Item.

For example, when creating an item request for a wine, you will enter basic information for the Parent Item [using these instructions](#). You will then follow the steps in [Create Wines Parent Item](#), after which you will follow the steps to [Add File Attachments and Item Images](#) and submit the item. Once the Parent Item is submitted, you will enter basic information for the related Supplier SCC/GTIN [using these instructions](#), then follow steps in [Create Wines Supplier SCC/GTIN](#) and submit the item.

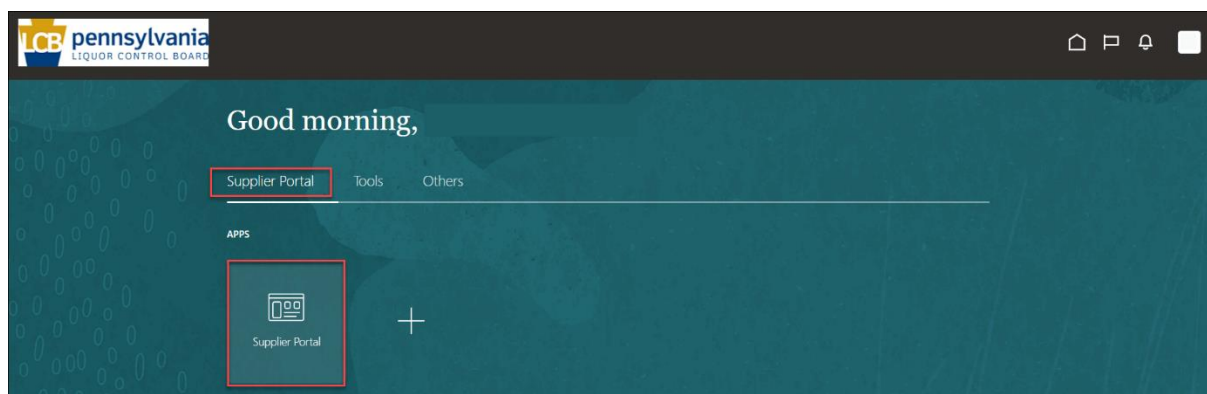
Create Parent Item (Oracle Supplier Portal)

1. Log in to the Oracle Supplier Portal:
 - a. Enter **User ID**
 - b. Enter **Password**
 - c. Click **Sign In**

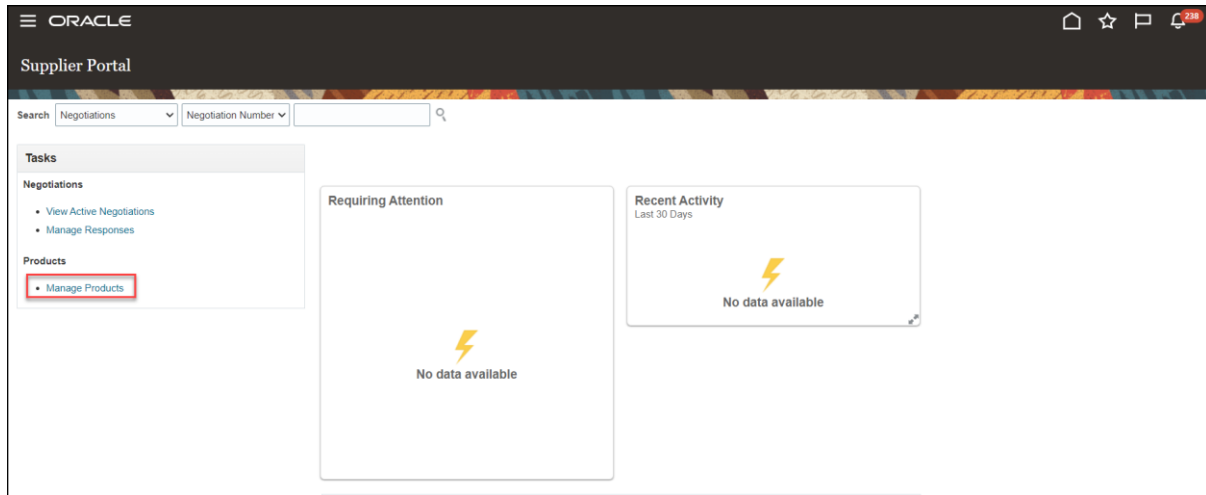


2. Navigate to the Welcome Springboard.
3. Click the **Supplier Portal Tab**, then click the **Supplier Portal Tile**.



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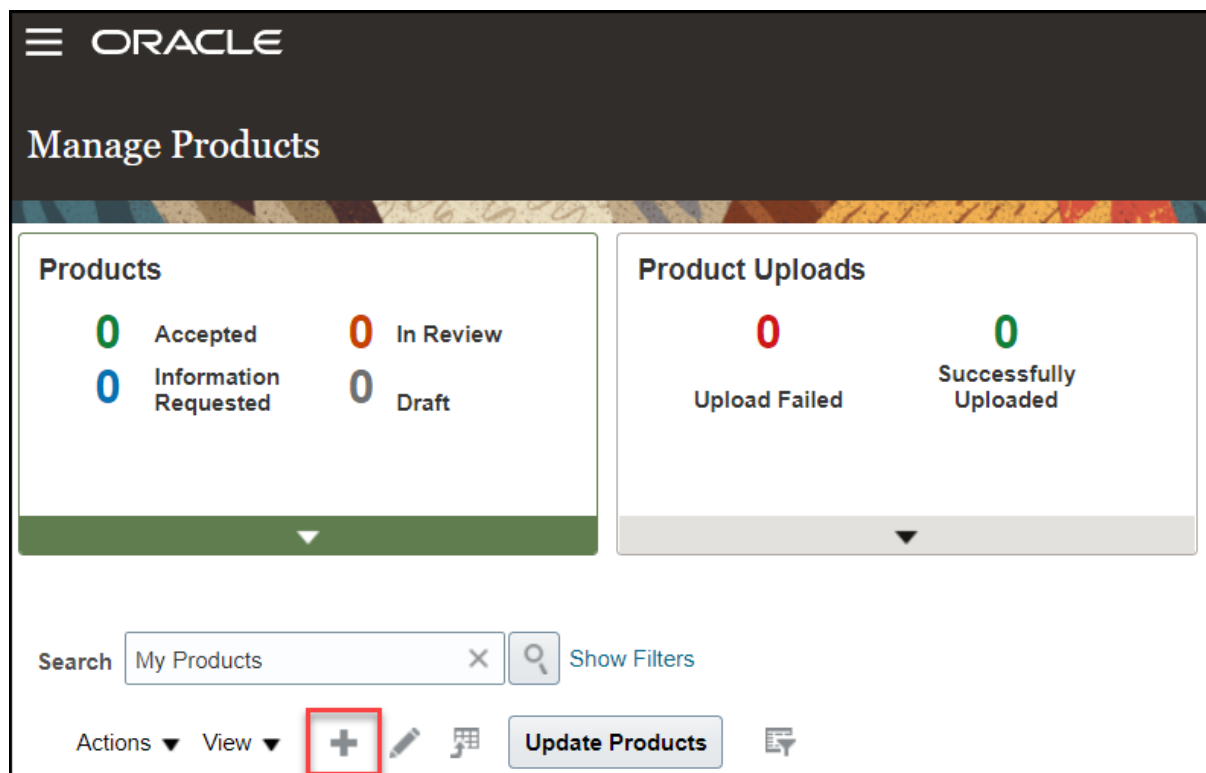
4. Click the **Manage Products** link on the left side of the screen under the Products Heading.



Note: You may need to scroll down through headings to see Manage Products > Manage Products.

The Manage Products screen will appear.

5. Click **+ Icon (Create)**.



The Create Product screen will appear.

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6. Select [Category] for the Parent Item from the dropdown menu in the Category Box using the following guidelines:

Category	Use when the item is ...
Parent Spirits	Vodka, gin, rum, whiskey, tequila, scotch, liqueur, cordials and others.
Parent Wines	All types of wine, including red, white, rosé, sparkling, dessert and others.
Parent Accessories	Corkscrews, bottle toppers, wine bags, glassware, barware and others.
Parent Consumables	Non-alcoholic items and cocktail garnishes such as olives, cherries, salt and others.

Notes: Values within dropdown fields display alphabetically, with only the first 10 values appearing in the dropdown list. Click “Search” to see more options. See the [Search Attributes in Oracle Supplier Portal](#) section for more information on how to search within dropdown fields.

Fields marked with a single asterisk (*) are mandatory fields and must be filled out, or an error message will appear and the item will not save. In some cases, you may need to accept the default value. “N/A” or “Other” may be available values if you do not have information for a field.

Attribute Groupings

Attributes — or fields — are organized in groups by category and differ by the category selected. For example, if you choose Parent Wines, only the fields for that category will appear. If you select Parent Spirits, a different set of fields appears. Refer to the screenshots on the next two pages for the order in which fields are grouped and the table that follows to show which groups appear for which category.

Click the triangle icon to the left of each group to expand or collapse the group of fields.

- 7. Enter the **Universal Product Code (UPC) Number** for the Parent Item in the Product Box.

Notes: Do not copy and paste into Oracle Supplier Portal fields. Doing so may cause an unexpected result and delay your submission.

The UPC must be unique. The PLCB can provide a 12-digit UPC if needed (for example, for a vintage product). You will enter this same number in the Product Supplier UPC field later in the steps and again if creating an associated Supplier SCC/GTIN. It is expected that these fields contain the same number and match.

Ensure there are no trailing spaces in any fields.

- 8. Enter the **Description** (or name of the item) according to the PLCB naming convention in the [E-commerce Policies and Procedures for Vendors document](#).

Notes: Use only alphanumeric characters in the description field. Do not use any special characters such as the percent symbol (%), ampersand (&), asterisk (*) or others.

Expert reviews will be added in step 10. A field to add tasting notes is included within the Global Attributes Section for each item type.

Click and drag the triangle in the lower right corner of the field to resize the box to see more content if necessary.

9. Select **Each** from the dropdown menu in the Primary Unit of Measure Box.

Note: Disregard and do not enter Pack Type, Global Trade Item Number, GTIN Unit of Measure, Manufacturer Part Number and Manufacturer Name fields. The PLCB does not use these fields.

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10. Enter an expert review, if your product has one, in the Formatted Description Box.

Note: These fields apply to one individual unit of the item. This is commonly referred to as “each” or “eaches.”

Selling Unit Weight*	Number	User	Enter the weight of the item in pounds or ounces, depending on Selling Unit Weight UOM selected.
Selling Unit Volume (Metric)*	Number	User	Enter volume in milliliters or liters.
Selling Unit Length*	Number	User	Enter the unit’s length (measure front to back between the bottle’s longest points) in inches. Note: If a bottle has a narrow base with a wider collar, enter the length of the collar (widest part of the bottle).

Notes: Selecting UPC Type without entering the Supplier UPC is considered incomplete.

There is no error checking (check digit) code to verify accuracy of barcode numbers in Oracle Supplier Portal. Examine the entry to verify the item number was entered accurately. You can also use an online barcode check digit calculator to confirm accuracy of your entry.
