

FINE WINE & GOOD SPIRITS

Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board (“PLCB”) Regulations presently mandate that prior to the in-store tasting event, sponsors are required to submit an Indemnity Against Liability form to the PLCB. A sponsor of a tasting event may be any licensed vendor, importer, distributor, importing distributor or manufacturer or its agent or employee who is 21 years of age or older.

The indemnification form can only be executed by individuals having the authority to legally bind sponsor. In the case of a corporation, this person may be the president, secretary, treasurer, or vice-president in charge of a principal business function. If the sponsor is a partnership, this person may be a general partner. However, the PLCB recognizes that circumstances may require that these individuals authorize representatives to act on their behalf.

Accordingly, the PLCB will allow for the delegation of signature authority under the following circumstances:

- A. The authorization form is submitted to the PLCB in writing; and
- B. The authorization specifies the individual or position responsible with actual authority to legally bind the sponsor; and
- C. The authorization clearly identifies the individual to whom the authority to execute an Indemnity Against Liability form on the sponsor’s behalf has been delegated.
