## VENDOR DRESS CODE IN FINE WINE & GOOD SPIRITS STORES

This document identifies the Vendor Dress Code for all vendors and their agents who conduct events in Fine Wine & Good Spirits stores. These events include in-store tastings, bottle signings, engravings, and promotional events, etc.

Vendors and their agents should present a neat, clean, and professional appearance in dress and grooming.

Radical departure from conventional dress and/or personal grooming is not permitted.

The following are dress requirements for all vendors and their agents working in FW&GS stores. The responsibility for compliance rests with the managing vendor of record.

**Acceptable Dress** – Vendors and their agents should be dressed in business casual attire for all in-store events. Dress should be professional in appearance. Vendor representatives are required to wear an apron while conducting tastings within the store. Aprons may be branded with vendor or brand-related logos. Vendor aprons must not be green or brown, so vendor representatives are not confused with FW&GS employees.

**Footwear** – Vendors and their agents should wear appropriate footwear – conservative walking shoes, loafers, flats, boots, athletic shoes, dress heels or leather deck-type shoes. Flashy athletic shoes, flip-flops, slippers and open-toed shoe are not acceptable.

**Inappropriate Dress** – Dress that is generally considered to be in poor taste by conventional standards is not permitted. Shorts, sundresses, tank tops, transparent clothing, spandex, athletic clothing, clothing featuring vulgarity or political statements and any clothing that could be perceived as too tight or low cut are not permitted for in-store tastings.

**Failure to Meet Standards** – Deviation from the above standards will not be tolerated and may result in cancellation of tastings and/or suspension of in-store tasting privileges.
